ROUTE 3 CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENTS - PENACOOK VILLAGE

Sidewalk work continued this past week in Penacook Village, which included the prepping, paving and loaming of several disturbed areas. Fairpoint continued lowering their duct bank, and street signs were installed along the southern portion of the project. Work next week will take place only on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday, due to Thanksgiving. Activities will include more sidewalk work, as well as loaming of the disturbed areas. One-way traffic will be maintained throughout the work zone and delays can be expected.
