CITY OFFICES CLOSED

In observance of New Year's Day, City offices and the Concord Public Library will be closed on Thursday, January 1st.

TRASH HOLIDAY

There will be no curbside trash or recycling collection on New Year's Day. Thursday's trash collection will occur on Friday, and Friday's collection will occur on Saturday.



CHRISTMAS TREE DISPOSAL

New this year, Concord residents who have curbside trash and recycling collection can place their Christmas trees at the curb for pick-up on their regularly scheduled collection day. Curbside collection of Christmas trees will take place for two weeks, from Monday, January 5th, through Friday, January 16th. All lights, ornaments, tinsel and other decorations must be removed from the tree before setting it at the curb. Wreaths and artificial trees will not be collected. Trees will not be accepted at White Farm or Beaver Meadow Golf Course this year. However, residents may bring trees to the Transfer Station through the month of January.



FALL LEAF COLLECTION

Highway and Utilities crews are continuing to collect leaves in the rural areas of Concord. Crews will continue with collection as weather permits. So far this year, crews have removed 1,367 loads of leaves (2,265 tons), compared to last year's 967 loads (1,516 tons). View our [online map](#) to see where crews have been.
