





In the fall of 2013, the City of Concord received a Community Planning Grant from the New Hampshire Housing Finance Authority to create a vision plan for the center of Penacook Village. The Plan will be presented to the Planning Board at their March 18th meeting and we anticipate that any zoning recommendations stemming from the Plan will make their way to City Council in late spring/early summer.
