MAIN STREET PROJECT

Main Street will continue to buzz with work next week. Everything from bricks and cobblestones to granite and top soil will be included. On Monday, crews will reclaim the remaining old road pavement at the south end of Main Street. Throughout the week, crews will continue placing cobblestones in the center median, pouring the concrete sidewalks around City Plaza, paving brick zones between Capitol and School Streets, and raising structure bases such as planters and granite seating. On Thursday, top soil for planters in front of the Prescription Center and City Plaza will be installed.



Due to refurbishment of the State House dome, Capitol Street will be closed to vehicles on Saturday. As a result, the Concord Farmers Market will be moved one block west to Capitol Street, between Green Street and North State Street, every Saturday through October 31st.

SEWALLS FALLS BRIDGE

This week's construction activities included the completion of the construction access road southwest of the existing bridge, mobilization of the first crane on site, and the start of demolition to the existing land spans.

In the upcoming weeks, demolition of the existing land spans will continue and construction of the work trestle will begin.



LIBERTY UTILITIES WORK

Liberty Utilities will be working at the following locations next week:

- Conant Drive, from Winant Street to Norwich Street;
- Thorndike Street, from Grove Street to South Street;
- Perley Street, from South State Street to Pierce Street; and
- Work is scheduled to begin between 203-274 South Street.

There may be delays, one-lane traffic, and encumbrances of parking spaces. Work will generally take place from 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday; and from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM on Saturday.

VEGETATION REMOVAL FUTURE STORRS ST. NORTH CONNECTOR

Removal of vegetation at the former Tsunis, Agway and Coastal Concrete properties, located between Storrs Street and Constitution Avenue, will begin next week. Work will include removal of all trash and brushy vegetation, minor grading, and the construction of an interim grass field, which will exist until such time as the future Storrs Street North Connector Road (CIP #18) is constructed. This work is scheduled to be completed by October 15th. The total cost of construction, excluding design and oversight, is \$112,730, and is being funded by the North End Opportunity Corridor Tax Increment Finance (TIF) District.
