### MAIN STREET

Work is progressing steadily in this final phase of the project. Base paving of the South Main Street work zone, from Fayette Street to Concord Street is scheduled for Monday, August 8th. Also on Monday, the curb and sidewalk on Pleasant Street, near “A Day to Remember Bridal Boutique” will be removed. The entrance to Bicentennial Square from Pleasant Street will be closed while this work is being done. This area at the Pleasant/North Main Street intersection will become another pedestrian crossing bumpout. The old concrete sidewalk in front of the Concord Food Co-op will also be removed on Monday.

Excavation for storm drain structures and underground utilities will continue throughout the week. Side streets bordering the work zone will be closed intermittently to accommodate this work, and, when closed, will be accessible from State Street. Local traffic will be able to access private parking lots; the public parking lot behind the former Employment Security building will be accessible from State Street; and the Concord Food Co-op parking lot will remain open at all times. Crews are scheduled to work this Saturday and next.



### SEWALLS FALLS BRIDGE

July marked a great month of construction progress on the Sewalls Falls Bridge. Structural steel girders spanning side to side are complete; and water, sewer, and gas utilities are being hung at this time. Concrete decking will begin in mid-August and continue through mid-September. Roadway and utility construction approaching the bridge on both sides is underway. By the end of August, we expect the bridge to really look like a bridge. The overall project is on schedule and on budget.
