MAIN STREET

Beginning today, and continuing through next week, traffic near the Concord Food Co-op will be reduced to stop and go at the exit area, while work is being done on the snow melt system in front of the building. A flagger will be on hand to assist customers as needed. Paving of the Co-op's driveway is tentatively scheduled for Thursday, August 25th. The Co-op is open and accessible; however, customers should use caution when entering and exiting.

Granite State Curbing will be on site tomorrow morning (Saturday, 8/20) to continue work in the area of Fayette Street heading south and on the center island curbing. Curb prep will also continue next week in the area of Pleasant Street.



WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT

- Rolfe Street: The contractor will be installing the water main and service connections next week.
- Merrimack Street: On Thursday, August 25th, starting at 7:00 PM, Merrimack Street will be closed, as the contractor will be tying in the new water main.
- Court Street: Towards the end of next week, the contractor will be paving driveways, installing curbing, and replacing sidewalks. Minor traffic delays are expected.
- Allen Street: The contractor will be installing sidewalk and handicap ramps next week.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS/ VOTER REGISTRATION



On **Tuesday, September 13th**, residents will have the opportunity to cast their vote in the **State Primary Election**. Polling locations within the City of Concord will be open from 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM.

Absentee ballots for the State Primary Election are now available from the City Clerk's Office. Residents who are unable to vote due to absence from town, religious observance, or physical disability may request an absentee ballot. You must be registered to vote prior to casting an absentee ballot. **September 6th is the last day residents may register to vote prior to the State Primary.**
