Suspect Arrested after Firing Dozens of Shots in Downtown Concord

CONCORD – On Wednesday June 14 at approximately 11:42pm Concord Police Officers responded to multiple reports of shots being fired in the area of Low Avenue, in the downtown section of the City. Witnesses reported that the male known to them had displayed a semi-automatic handgun to them. The male then walked to Low Ave. which parallels N. Main St. where it is believed that he discharged approximately thirty rounds from a 9mm pistol.

Responding officers located the suspect walking north on N. Main St. in close proximity to where the shots were fired. He was immediately detained. Concord Police Officer and NH State Troopers located a 9mm semi-automatic firearm, expended ammunition magazines, and numerous shell casings along Low Ave. There were no reports of injuries. Police continue to investigate this morning to determine if any property was damaged.
