### I-93 BOW-CONCORD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

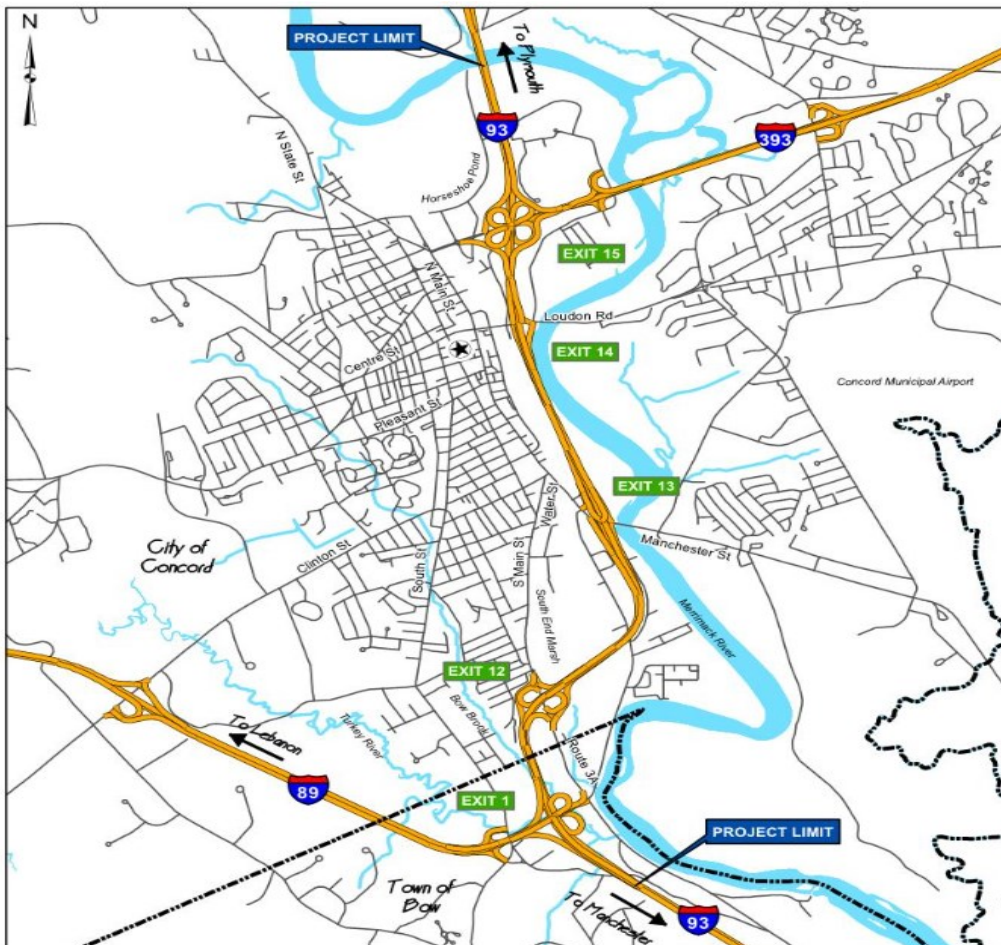
The New Hampshire Department of Transportation (NHDOT) will hold two **Public Informational Meetings** to review and discuss the widening of I-93 from the I-93/I-89 interchange in Bow, northerly approximately four miles, to the I-93/I-393 interchange in Concord. In addition to the I-93/I-89 interchange, the project will include interchange reconstruction/reconfiguration at Exits 12, 13, 14 and 15 on I-93; Exit 1 on I-89; and Exit 1 on I-393.
