ENGINEER’S ESTIMATE

The Engineer’s estimate for this project is \$675,000 - \$725,000

QUESTIONS RECEIVED FROM PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS DURING PRE-BID:

1. Is the City responsible for all Quality Control Testing?

Response: The City will perform Quality Assurance testing to determine if materials meet the technical specifications to determine acceptance. This does not relieve the Contractor from performing proper Quality Control of the Materials being incorporated into the work.

2. Are there any provisions to hold water at the upstream dam?

Response: The City has not entered into any agreement with the dam owners, therefore there are no provisions in the contract to require the dam to reduce flows in the canal. This does not preclude the contractor from entering into agreements with the dam owner at their own cost.

3. Are there concerns about vibratory monitoring?

Response: There are no provisions in the contract for monitoring vibrations. The contractor’s attention is directed to the two penstocks that run below the canal under the bridge. The contractor would be responsible for any damage to the penstocks caused by their means and methods.


