RESOLUTION

Reconstituting the City of Concord's Recycling Committee to the Solid Waste Advisory Committee

The City of Concord resolves as follows:

WHEREAS; members of the City's Recycling Committee believe that they have achieved its initial objectives for promoting recycling activities within the City of Concord; and,

WHEREAS; the Recycling Committee has assisted staff with developing and implementing plans for both short term and long term recycling projects within the City; and,

WHEREAS; the present Recycling Committee membership strongly feel that the Committee should be reconstituted and renamed the Solid Waste Advisory Committee; and,

WHEREAS; the purposes of the Solid Waste Advisory Committee would be to address general policy issues affecting the City's involvement with solid waste matters. Such matters include but are not limited to, curbside recycling, commercial recycling, residential refuse collections, landfill monitoring, fee for service proposals, Downtown Solid Waste District, Concord Regional COOP, landfill closure activities, sludge composting and other waste reduction issues; and,

WHEREAS; the Solid Waste Advisory Committee will also recommend for City staff and Council in implementing any revisions to solid waste policies affecting the City of Concord; and,

Now therefore be it resolved:

1. That the Mayor be authorized to reconstitute the Recycling Committee to the Solid Waste Advisory Committee.
2. That the Committee serve in an advisory capacity to City Council for addressing a wide range of solid waste management issues.
3. That the Mayor appoint Committee members from interested volunteers from the former Recycling Committee, general public, Downtown Solid Waste District, business sector, public agencies, and City staff officials from Public Works, Water Resources and City Manager's office.

The City of Concord resolves as follows:

4. That the size of the committee shall be made up of no more than ten (10) members.
5. That the term of appointments will be two years, and from time to time the Mayor may appoint new members to replace those who for any reason are unable to continue to serve for the balance of the term of the original members.
6. The City Council may vote to extend the committee at the end of the two-year term.
7. That this resolution shall take effect upon its passage.
