


# CPL TEEN SUMMER READING PROGRAM



**20,000 LEAGUES UNDER THE SEA** / Jules Verne.

**FIC VER (Adult Storage) / PBC VERNE (Penacook)**

A nineteenth-century science fiction tale of an electric submarine, its eccentric captain, and undersea world, which anticipated many of the scientific achievements of the twentieth century. 1870.

**THE ARM OF THE STARFISH** / Madeleine L'Engle.

**Y PBC LENGLE**

Young Adam Eddington becomes entangled in international intrigue involving murder and kidnapping when he takes a summer job in Portugal assisting a noted marine biologist whose scientific findings are fought for by world powers. 1965.

**THE BRIDES OF ROLLROCK ISLAND** / Margo Lanagan.

**Y LANAGAN (Penacook)**

A fisherman on remote Rollrock Island becomes a witch's victim when he falls desperately in love with the beautiful sea-wife he has captured. 2012.

**CINDER** / Marissa Meyer.

**Y MEYER & FIC MEYER (YA section)**

As plague ravages the overcrowded Earth, observed by a ruthless lunar people, Cinder, a gifted mechanic and cyborg, becomes involved with handsome Prince Kai and must uncover secrets about her past in order to protect the world in this futuristic take on the Cinderella story. 2012.

**THE CITY OF EMBER** / Jeanne DuPrau.

In the year 241, twelve-year-old Lina trades jobs on Assignment Day to be a Messenger to run to new places in her decaying but beloved city, perhaps even to glimpse Unknown Regions. 2003.

When sixteen-year-old orphan Tessa Fell's older brother suddenly vanishes, she discovers that she herself is a Downworlder, and she must learn to trust the Shadowhunters if she ever wants to find her brother. 2010.

**FABLEHAVEN** / Brandon Mull.

**J MULL**

**(Fablehaven series #1, more books available)**

When Kendra and Seth go to stay at their grandparents' estate, they discover that it is a sanctuary for magical creatures and that a battle between good and evil is looming. 2006.

**THE FELLOWSHIP OF THE RING** / J.R.R. Tolkien.

**Y PBC TOLKIEN / FIC TOLKIEN (Main Floor)**

**(Lord of the Rings series #1, more books available)**

It is up to the unlikely hero Frodo and his faithful servant Sam to carry the Ring to where it could be destroyed - in the very center of Sauron's dark kingdom. 1954.

**THE GRAVEYARD BOOK** / Neil Gaiman

**Y GAIMAN**

Raised since he was a baby by ghosts, werewolves, and other residents of the cemetery in which he has always resided, Bod wonders how he will manage to survive amongst the living with only the lessons he has learned from the dead... 2008.

**GREGOR THE OVERLANDER** / Suzanne Collins.

**J PBC COLLINS**

When eleven-year-old Gregor and his two-year-old sister are pulled into a strange underground world, they trigger an epic battle involving men, bats, rats, cockroaches, and spiders while on a quest foretold by ancient prophecy. 2003.

**THE HOBBIT** / J.R.R. Tolkien.

Bilbo Baggins, a respectable, well-to-do hobbit, lives comfortably in his hobbit-hole until the day the wandering wizard Gandalf chooses him to take part in an adventure from which he may never return. *1937.*

**INCARCERON** / Catherine Fisher.

**FIC FISHER (YA section)**

(*Incarceron Series #1, more books available*)

In Incarceron, a vast intelligent city-prison sealed off from the outside world and hidden from everybody except the Warden, two young people, Cynthia, the Warden's daughter who is trying to escape an arranged marriage, and Finn, a young prisoner who cannot remember his childhood, join forces to attempt to escape. *2010.*

**LIFE AS WE KNEW IT** / Susan Beth Pfeffer.

**FIC PFEFFER (YA section)**

Through journal entries sixteen-year-old Miranda describes her family's struggle to survive after a meteor hits the moon, causing worldwide tsunamis, earthquakes, and volcanic eruptions. *2006.*

**THE MAZE RUNNER** / James Dashner.

**Y DASHNER**

(*Maze Runner series #1, more books available*)

Sixteen-year-old Thomas wakes up with no memory in the middle of a maze and realizes he must work with the community in which he finds himself if he is to escape. *2009.*

**PRIDE AND PREJUDICE AND ZOMBIES** / Seth Grahame-Smith.

**FIC GRAHAMES (Main floor)**

A mysterious plague has fallen upon the quiet English village of Meryton--and the dead are returning to life! Feisty heroine Elizabeth Bennet is determined to wipe out the zombie menace, but she's soon distracted by the arrival of the haughty and arrogant Mr. Darcy. *2009.*

**RAVENWOOD** / Andrew Peters.

**J PETERS & Y PETER (Penacook)**

On Arborium, the last forested island in the future, fourteen-year-old Ark, who lives in a mile-high city set in the tree tops, overhears a plot to rob Arborium of its wood, a natural resource more precious than gold. *2011.*

**RISE AGAIN** / Ben Tripp.

**FIC TRIPP (Main floor)**

Sheriff Danielle Adelman is threatened when her small town of Forest Peak is in danger of being overrun by residents who have suddenly died and become zombies and she flees across the California desert, searching for her missing sister. *2010.*

**SHIP BREAKER** / Paolo Bacigalupi.

**FIC BACIGALU (YA section)**

In a futuristic world, teenaged Nailer scavenges copper wiring from grounded oil tankers for a living, but when he finds a beached clipper ship with a girl in the wreckage, he has to decide if he should strip the ship for its wealth or rescue the girl. *2010.*

**SOUL SURFER** / Bethany Hamilton

**797.3 HAMILTON (Main floor)**

The teenage surfer who lost her arm in a shark attack in 2003 describes how she has coped with this life-altering event with the help of her faith, the changes in her life, and her return to the sport she loves. *2006.*

**THE STRANGE CASE OF DR. JEKYLL AND MR. HYDE** /

Robert Louis Stevenson

**FIC STEVENSO / L FIC STEVENSO**

The Strange Case of Dr. Jekyll and Mr. Hyde dramatically brings to life a science-fiction case study of the nature of good and evil and the duality that can exist within one person. *1886.*

**UN LUN DUN** / China Mieville.

**FIC MIEVILLE (YA section)**

Stumbling into an alternate funhouse version of her home city, twelve-year-old Londoner Deeba finds herself trapped in a world of killer giraffes, animated umbrellas, and ghost children, and must take on the role of savior to prevent utter destruction. *2007.*

**THE WIND IN THE WILLOWS** / Kenneth Grahame

**J GRA**

The escapades of four animal friends who live along a river in the English countryside. *1908.*

**ZOMBIE ISLAND** / Lori Handeland.

**FIC HANDELAN (Main floor)**

(*A Shakespeare Undead Novel*)

Vampire William Shakespeare concocts a plan to rid Katherine of her husband, but when they are shipwrecked on an island ruled by a wizard and a nymph they encounter a larger plot leading to the royal palace of Queen Elizabeth. *2012.*
