The following is a brief history of the Concord Seventh-day Adventist Church located at 21 Dunklee Street, Concord, New Hampshire.

The Seventh-day Adventist Church in Concord, N. H. was organized in the year, 1906. Among the names of the charter members appear those of Mr. and Mrs. Fred S. Stray, Mr. and Mrs. George Clark, Mr. and Mrs. F. S. Hartwell, Mrs. Susie E. Drake and Mr. William Brown. The officiating Pastor was Pastor W. H. Holden.

For a number of years the small group met in various rented quarters in the City of Concord. In 1929 the presently occupied church building was purchased and was dedicated on June 24 of that year. The Pastor at that time was Pastor H. P. Gramm.

Among the Pastors of following years are the names of R. A. Mitchell, Jack Clark, George Rice, C. E. Kellogg and the present Pastor, Robert N. Edwards.
