



Trail Manners for You and Your Dog

1. Respect wildlife and their habitat - you are in their home.
2. Respect the environment - don't let your dog dig or cause damage.
3. Leave only paw prints! Clean up after your dog, it's the right thing to do, and it's the law.
4. Yield the right-of-way to other hikers. Many people, kids, and other dogs are afraid. Communicate with others; always keep your dog under control, and respect concerns of other trail users.
5. Always be courteous. Don't give other trail users any reason to complain. Set an example for others by being a conscientious owner with a well-behaved dog out enjoying the trails.
