Collection Services

The City of Concord's contractor for solid waste and recycling services is Casella Resource Solutions. Collection services occur Monday through Friday (and through Saturday for trash holiday weeks). Trash and recycling are collected from your scheduled area once each week.



Trash and recycling must be curbside by 7:00am on your collection day. A recycling bin has been provided for each residence by the City of Concord; however, any rigid container is acceptable to be used if it is clearly labeled as recycling. Recycling labels and replacement bins are available at Concord General Services.

Only acceptable materials will be collected. **PLEASE DO NOT USE PLASTIC BAGS FOR RECYCLING.**

Furniture, appliances, and all other bulky items should be brought to the Transfer Station. Bulky items will not be accepted curbside. Fees will apply for all items except recyclables. Please see the attendant for items such as tires, motor oil, anti-freeze, thermostats, thermometers, car batteries, cell phones, and fluorescent bulbs. Christmas trees will be accepted through the month of January. Confirm additional acceptable materials and rates by calling the Transfer Station or visit www.concordnh.gov/transferstation.

Concord residents can drop-off leaves and grass clippings to be recycled into compost for free if the load size is pick-up truck sized or smaller. The Earth Materials Recycling Center also allows for disposal of brush, snow, asphalt, and concrete for a fee (dependent on the load size). Proof of residency is required. Pay-As-You-Throw Program

The City of Concord is encouraging the community to produce less trash to decrease the environmental impact of solid waste by following a unit-based pricing system for trash. The City of Concord established a Pay-As-You-Throw Program in July 2009 that allows residents to be in direct control of how much they pay for solid waste based on how much they throw away. **Trash tonnage in Concord has been reduced by 40% and recycling tonnage has increased by over 100% since the PAYT Program began in July 2009!**

Residents with curbside trash collection are required to use pay-as-you-throw (PAYT) trash bags. There is no limit to how many bags can be placed curbside each week, but **the more you recycle - the more you can save by using less bags!**

Trash Holiday (New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day)
There is no curbside collection on trash holidays. Each day that follows a trash holiday has postponed collection by one day for the remainder of the week through Saturday.

Christmas Tree Collection (January 4th - January 15th)

Christmas trees will be collected curbside on your collection day. Wreaths or artificial trees will not be collected. Please remove all lights, ornaments, tinsel, and all other decorations from the tree.

Spring Leaf Collection (April 25th - June 4th; No Weekends; Delayed Collection Day In Last Week)

An unlimited amount of leaves and grass clippings can be placed curbside for collection on your regular collection day. Leaves must be by the curb by 7:00am and be in brown biodegradable yard waste bags or in a labeled rigid container (no plastic bags). Dates are weather permitting. Household Hazardous Waste Day (September 17th, 9:00am-3:00pm)

Bring your household hazardous waste to the Everett Arena at 15 Loudon Road from 9:00am to 3:00pm to safely dispose of toxic materials. Find more information and a list of acceptable and unacceptable items to bring at www.concordnh.gov/hhw. Proof of residency is required.

Fall Leaf Collection (October 31st - December 9th; No Weekends; No Thanksgiving Or Day After)

Rake all leaves to the curb (unbagged) for City collection. It cannot be predicted when crews will reach certain locations due to unpredictable leaf volumes and weather conditions, so be ready by the start of the program to make sure you don't miss collection since crews will only have time to come by once! Crews will not pick up on private property. Leaves are the only acceptable material that will be collected, but branches and brush can be brought to Earth Materials Recycling Center for a fee.
