Accept minutes from last meeting.

1. Terrill Park Update. City Council reviewed the concept and staff to increase the number of parking spaces (may be needed for larger events) and consider adding a bus drop off/turn around area – VHB will be here to review updated concept for review.
2. The State of NH would like to cut EAB infested ash trees at Healy Park – Planning Staff will review request.
3. Each year Planning Staff coordinates a project on the trails with St. Paul’s School students, this year they would like to build a 12’ long footbridge with railings at Garrison Park to replace the stone bridge that collapsed several years ago. Planning Staff will review request with you.
4. Request for a park bench donation – Chris Jacques will review request.
5. [New Winter Brochure](#) is now online and copies have been delivered to area schools. Laura Bryant will review programs
6. Fall Program updates – Laura Bryant will update on the current programs that are running.

**CIP Updates:**

**Rollins Park CIP** – Work is underway. This phase will be finished by Thanksgiving.

**New Community Center** – Metal framing for new section will start going up this month. Currently on budget and on track to open June 2018. Final opening date will not be confirmed until spring 2018. I would like to schedule a time for RPAC members to come see the new building (will need to be 3 pm timeframe)

**New Skate House** - Staff is currently creating a RFQ to hire a Construction Manager to work with staff this winter.

**Terrill Park CIP** – will have new concept at meeting.

**Keach Park CIP** – Courts have been repainted and new backboards installed. Should have new pickleball lines painted this month.

**Memorial Field CIP** - complete replacement of 5 tennis courts is underway. All ten courts currently closed for work this fall. 5 courts will reopen regular time in spring, with the five new courts reopening around June 1, 2018
