Accept minutes from last meeting.

1. Merrimack River Greenway Trail: Dick Lemieux and Greg Bakos will provide an overview of the proposed trail and how it connects with Terrill Park. Next summer part of the elevated walkway will be constructed on the north side of Terrill Park.
2. Referral from City Council (see attached): regarding allowing hunting on conservation lands.
3. Last month The State of NH asked to cut several EAB infested ash trees at Healy Park – however they have requested a different location as the trees at Healy Park are not suitable. Working with the Planning Staff they would now like to do the work on couple of infested trees at Terrill Park instead of Healy Park.
4. Director's recommendation on having No Hockey Signs Posted at White Park.

CIP Updates:

Rollins Park CIP – Scheduled work for this fall is completed. Next spring we will begin to replant trees. See flyer advertising our Adopt A Tree Program at Rollins Park.

New Community Center – Work continues on the city's new community center. In the 1960's section spray foam insulation was installed on all exterior walls which will increase the energy efficiency of the building, remaining new windows will be installed next week and drywall hanging will begin. Exterior and internal framing is ongoing on the new section of the community center and will continue for the next couple of weeks. Work also started on the new roof for the entire building and will continue for the next couple of weeks as well.

New Skate House - RFQ to hire a Construction Manager will be on the streets by the first week of December.

Terrill Park CIP – last's concept was approved at the October Meeting.

Keach Park CIP – Courts have been repainted and new backboards installed. Should have new pickleball lines painted this month.

Memorial Field CIP – Work has finished for this season. Work will resume in spring with the goal to have the five new courts reopening around June 1, 2018
