Review and approve the meeting minutes from the March 2025 meeting

New Business:

1. City Council referral regarding Beaver Meadow Golf Course
2. Review pending larger CIP Projects:
 - Terrill Park – *fully designed and permitted*: \$5 - \$8 million
 - White Park Pond Restoration - *fully design and permitted*. Working on estimate: \$500,000 - \$1 million
 - Kiwanis Riverfront Park – currently in final design and permitting: \$8 – \$10 million
 - Skate Park Construction: Received \$500,000 LWCF Grant, group raising the match (\$500,000)
 - Memorial Field Complex – Draft Master Plan – project cost up to \$28.5 million
 - Blossom Cemetery buildings – in process of being addressed. \$5 million +/-
 - Canterbury Road parking lot expansion at City Wide Community Center/Keach Park: \$1.5 - 2 million
 - Buy new park and cemetery land – unknow cost. Ward 2 does not have public park
 - Playground replacement (all parks next 4 - 6 years) - \$300,000 - 500,000 per playground
 - Pool Renovations (Garrison and Rollins): \$600,000 – 900,000 per pool
 - Install irrigation at Rolfe and Rollins Park: cost TBA
3. FY26 Budget Overview – Parks and Rec budget review is on Thursday, May 22
