Michael Bezanson called the meeting to order at 2:06 PM.

APPROVAL OF 3/28/23 MEETING MINUTES

Mr. Bezanson opened the item. Heather Shank moved to approve the 3/28/23 Poles and Wires Committee meeting minutes. Chip Chesley seconded the motion to accept the minutes. The minutes were approved.

Mr. Bezanson asked Paul Gendron to outline the agenda. Mr. Gendron stated that there is one project on the agenda for segTEL, d/b/a FirstLight Fiber.

FINAL APPLICATION

1. segTEL, Inc., d/b/a FirstLight Fiber, request for licensure of fiber optic within a City Right-of-Way. Storrs Street

Mr. Gendron stated that this application is for fiber optic along Storrs Street. He stated that the fiber is starting at existing plant on the west side of Storrs Street, and then proceeding easterly across Storrs Street to an existing pole in the right of way, then continuing easterly and then southerly to the northeast corner of the capitol shopping plaza. He stated that the Committee was approving the connection between the existing plant on the west side of Storrs Street to the first pole on the east side of Storrs

Street. The remaining poles on the application are not under the jurisdiction of the City because they are on private property. He recommended that the application be approved for the two poles on Storrs Street. Mr. Chesley made a motion to approve the application. Mr. Bezanson seconded the motion and the application was approved.
