Section 1:	Amend the Municipal Code of Ordinances, Title V, Administrative Code, Article 30-3, Boards and Commissions, by adding thereto the following new section:
	30-3-10 Everett Arena Advisory Committee
	(a) The Everett Arena Advisory Committee shall consist of seven members. The Manager of the Arena shall be the Clerk of the Committee. The members of the Committee shall be appointed as follows:

	2. One City Councilor to be appointed by the Mayor;
	The Director of Recreation and Parks as Ex-officio, non-voting member.
	4. The Committee shall elect its own Chairman and Vice Chairman

	1. submit an annual report to the City Council on the state of the Arena;
