

Summer Camp and COVID-19



Concord Parks & Recreation is very excited to be able to run our summer camps this year! Knowing that it won't be a typical summer we are committed to providing the best experience possible for your child. We understand some of these changes may feel uncomfortable but they have all been made in order keep campers and staff as safe as possible throughout the summer.

Changes to Camp

- We will follow the NH Best Practices Guidelines
- Each camp is limited to a total of 20 kids per camp - small groups will stay together all week
- Camp hours are 8:30 am - 4:30 pm
- Campers will need to bring their own lunch and snack as well as a water bottle with a cover
- Campers should arrive with sunscreen applied; they will be reminded to reapply throughout the day, and should a camper need assistance counselors will wear a mask and gloves
- Campers will be assigned a cubby for the week where they will need to keep their belongings
- Water fountains will be for bottle refills only
- Campers will be outside as much as possible and will have access to the amenities at Keach Park, including the pool
- Campers will need to wear a mask when in common areas of the community center such as bathrooms and walking in the hallways
- Campers participating in Adventure camp will be required to wear a mask while riding on the bus

Daily Drop off and Pickup Procedure

- Drop off and pick up will take place outside; parents will not be allowed into the Community Center
- Campers will be checked in outside each day; campers will have a temperature check and parents will be asked to answer a few questions
- Campers need to bring a clean cloth or new disposable mask to camp each day

Camp Staff

- Staff will have a temperature check and complete a health survey daily
- Camp Counselors will wear mask when indoors or unable to safely social distance
- Camp counselors will ask campers to frequently wash hands or use sanitizer when transitioning from one activity to the next

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Camp Schedule and Activities

- Camp groups will remain the same all week
- Lunch time will be staggered and campers will eat outside whenever possible
- Campers will be encouraged to wash hands frequently
- Camp rooms will be thoroughly disinfected following CDC guidelines each night after camp

Daily Health Checks

Each day at arrival all staff and campers will be asked several health questions. If yes to any of the following staff and/or camp will not be allowed to attend camp:

- * Have you had any close contact with someone suspected or confirmed to have COVID19?
- * Had a fever within the past 48 hours (100.4 or above).
- * Traveled internationally within the past 14 days

Increased Cleaning

- Camp rooms and all equipment will be thoroughly disinfected following CDC guidelines each night
- Frequent cleaning of door handles, tables and chairs will take place throughout the day
- Bathrooms will be cleaned on an hourly basis

Campers not feeling well

- Campers who arrive with a fever of 100.4 or higher will not be able to stay at camp
- Campers with **suspected or confirmed** Covid-19 will need to stay out of camp for at least 10 days and have no symptoms for 72 hours (3 days) before returning to camp
- Campers who feel ill at camp will put on a mask and be moved to a private room to await pick up
- If we have a confirmed case of Covid-19 at camp we will contact Disease Control and wait for further directions
