

Permit and Inspection Requirements for PV Solar Installations

A building permit is required for any installation of PV solar panels either roof mounted or ground mounted.

An electrical permit is also required for any installation of PV solar panels.

Permit Application requirements for Ground Mounted Systems:

- Plan showing layout and location of solar array on the lot.
- Completed building permit application.

Permit Application Requirements for Roof Mounted Systems

- Plan showing the array layout on the roof.
- Verification, typically by a registered design professional or structural engineer, that the roof is capable of supporting the loads imposed and a description of what, if any, reinforcement is required.
- Completed building permit application.

Inspections:

- All PV Solar systems must be inspected by the Electrical Inspector. The Electrical Inspector will also perform the building inspection for Ground Mounted PV Arrays.
- All Roof Mounted PV Arrays must be inspected by the Electrical Inspector as well as by the Building Inspector. Engineering information must be on site at the time of the inspection for the Building Inspector.
